Off the pitch the new stadium developments will overhaul Park Hall Stadium, transforming the match day experience and providing improved facilities for the local community to benefit from. We have a role to play as a club, and we want to use the power of football to inspire and help people from all walks of life.

We are a community, a team and we want to work together to continue to set the standards in Welsh football but also to make our mark on European football and take this club to where it truly belongs.

ABOUT TNS: HISTORY

The New Saints of Oswestry Town is the most successful club in the history of the JD Cymru Premier, where we are currently defending champions. This success has enabled the club to consistently qualify for major European competitions, playing regularly in both the UEFA Champions League and the UEFA Europa League against some of Europe's biggest clubs including Liverpool and Manchester City.

The New Saints of Oswestry Town was formed as a result of the merger of Llansantffraid and Oswestry Town in 2003 and played as Total Network Solutions, the multi-million pound company that was eventually acquired by BT in 2005.

The New Saints FC have won the league title on 15 occasions, the JD Welsh Cup nine times and hold the record for most European appearances by any Welsh side. Furthermore, The New Saints FC are one of just three clubs to play 1,000 games in the JD Cymru Premier League.

OUR LOCATION

Situated around one and half miles northeast of the English town of Oswestry, the second biggest town in Shropshire with an estimated population of 18,000 people, since 2007, The New Saints FC have played their home games at Park Hall Stadium. There is a local daily bus service from Oswestry Town Centre. The nearest train station to Park Hall Stadium is Gobowen.

Park Hall Stadium has a state-of-the-art 3G pitch, the ground is fully floodlit with 500 Lux lights and the club recently received planning permission to expand the ground capacity to 1,600 seated seats at a cost of approximately £1 million. This ensures Park Hall will be able to welcome Europe's elite for our matches in competitions such as the UEFA Champions League.

We are proud to be at the centre of the local community and our facilities cater for a diverse and wide range of people. Park Hall Stadium also features a function room, a 10 pin bowling alley, and bar and catering facilities. The facilities benefit the whole of the community creating a family entertainment facility in the heart of Oswestry which caters for all ages and abilities.

Formed in 2002, managed by club legend Greg Draper, The New Saints Women play in the Genero Adran Premier, the highest level of women's football in Wales. The team has been very successful, having most recently been awarded the FAW Tier One licence for the 2023/24 season. In their second season in the Genaro Arden Premier, The New Saints FC Women finished in fourth position. Manager Greg Draper was nominated for 'Manager of the Year' and young defender Izzy Redding nominated for young player of the year. There is also a thriving junior section, comprising under-15s and under-16s teams, with the establishment of an Under-19s Development Team.

ACADEMY TEAM

The New Saints of Oswestry Town was the first Welsh Premier League club to be awarded official Academy accreditation in 2002, after the introduction of the UEFA Licensing Procedure for clubs competing in national leagues throughout Europe. The Academy programme now caters for over 200 players from the age of 7-19 yrs.

The key objectives of the Academy are to:

- · Establish The New Saints as a focus for young players locally
- Improve the standard of young players in the area
- Provide opportunities for players to compete at the highest possible level
- Increase the quality and number of trained adults working with young players in the area

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME:

In 2003, The New Saints has established a full time scholarship programme for 16-19 year olds in conjunction with North Shropshire College in Oswestry. The Scholarship programme is now known as the Performance Phase and involves a number of youngsters, who combine football and education as part of their course.

When the works are completed in the summer, Park Hall Stadium will hold a seated capacity of 1,700. As well as football matches, the stadium also plays host to several community family and school events throughout the season.


